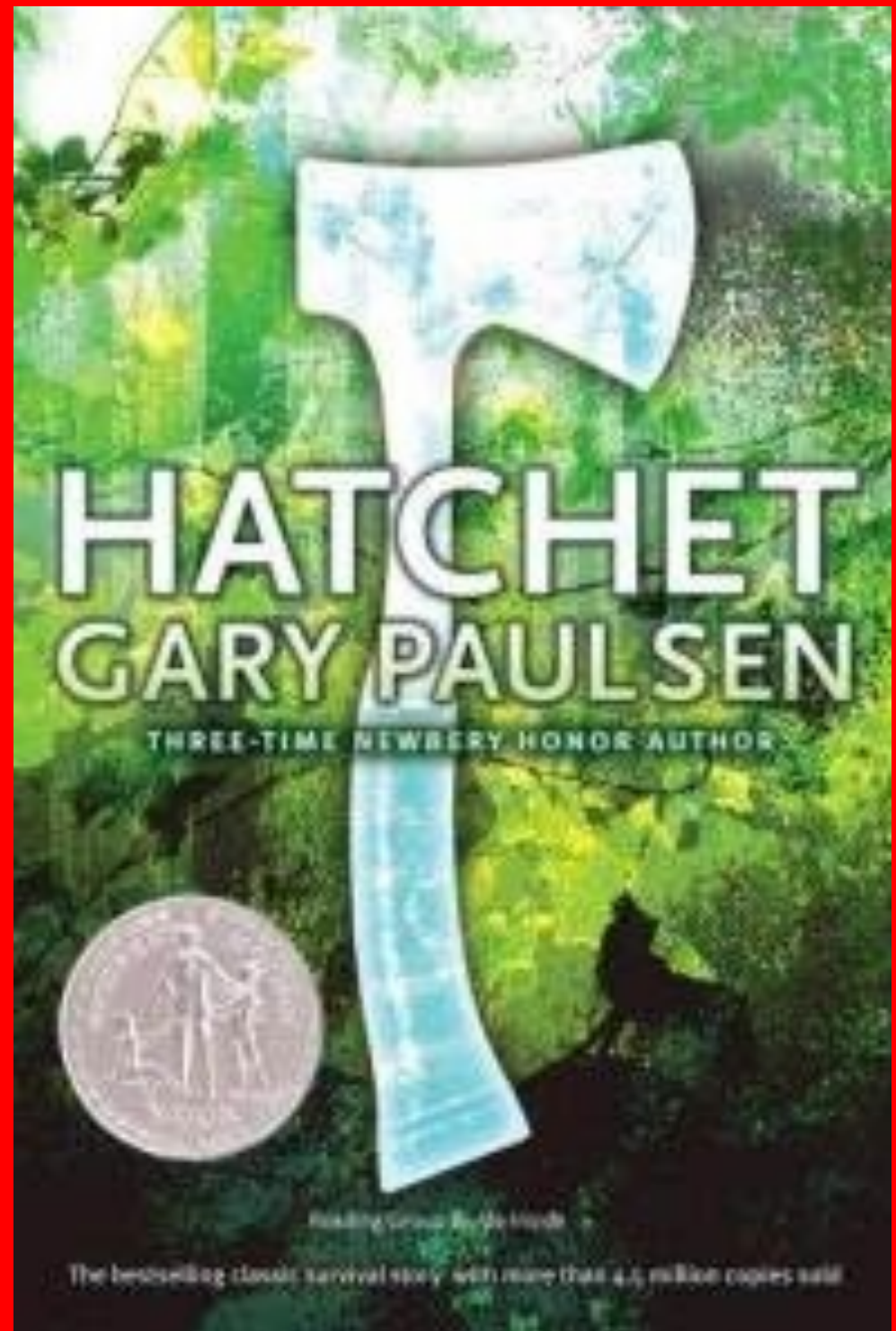




Hatchet Summary:
